The first Rotaract club was the Rotaract Club of North Charlotte in North Carolina, founded on March 13, 1968. Today, there are more than 10,000 clubs in over 189 countries worldwide. Since then, Rotaract has grown into one of Rotary's most significant and fastest-growing service programs.

Rotaract is a global organisation that empowers students and young professionals to create positive change in their local communities and around the world. Rotaract provides unique opportunities that assist its members in becoming the business and professional leaders of tomorrow.

Various social events are held throughout the year to promote a social environment for our members as well as inter-club events to ensure that strong ties are made between Rotaract clubs.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

The Rotaract motto is "Service above Self". Our main goals are to improve the world around us through service. Depending on the interests of the members, our community projects can be quite diverse. Such community-based service projects may include:

- ✓ Educational projects such as tutoring programmes or mentoring.
- ✓ Supporting disadvantaged or disabled people.
- ✓ Addressing homelessness in the community.
- ✓ Environmental projects such as "Clean Up Australia Day" or restoring vegetation.
- ✓ Supporting existing charity groups.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICE

The club aims to expand the members understanding of the work environment and business opportunities in the community. Also, that undertaking volunteer work and how it is relevant to the work place such as communication, compromise and understanding of other parties.

Examples of activities which are provided by Rotaract and Rotary for professional development are:

- ✓ Seminars on management and marketing.
- ✓ Leadership development courses such as RYLA.
- ✓ Guest speakers on a variety of topics such as finance and resume writing.

- ✓ Ensuring all people have basic human rights.
- ✓ Environmental projects such as supporting a sustainable lifestyle.
